Required Fundraising (K - 12)

- For the above tuition rates to be possible, assistance with school fundraising is necessary.
- Families with students in grades K-12 are required annually through raffle sales, a personal tax-deductible donation, or a combination thereof to fundraise \$750 per family.

- While not required, please also consider directing a portion of your tithe or a monthly gift to Holy Angels so it can keep tuition low for all & continue its mission. Tuition & fees only cover about 64% of the cost to educate each child.

Payment Plan (Preschool - 12)

- Monthly payment plan: August 1st - May 1st (Preschool - 12); payment due by 1st of the month
- Payment in full before the first day of school or Alumni Parent - 2% discount (K-12)
- Family tuition cap: \$21,115, not including preschool/prekindergarten (no additional discounts)

Explanation of Discounts (K - 12)

- Payment-in-full and alumni discounts cannot be combined.
- Families receiving financial assistance through the CEF and/or Holy Angels Academy are not eligible for pre-payment or alumni discounts.
- Families at the family tuition cap of \$21,115 are not eligible for pre-payment or alumni discounts.

Payment Policies

1. A \$50.00 late fee may be charged for payments that are 5 or more days past due.
2. Method of Payment: Tuition will be processed through the FACTS school information system
3. Timely payments are critical to operations. Thus, the Academy reserves the right to revoke continued enrollment for any family that falls one or more months behind on tuition payments. If a family needs a special arrangement, the Academy must be contacted to request it.
4. Delinquent Tuition: Report cards and permanent records, including health records, will be withheld at the end of the school year if required payments are not made in full, unless alternative arrangements have been made. In addition, quarterly report cards may be withheld for delinquency with payments. If collection efforts are undertaken, the delinquent party will be responsible for reasonable attorney fees and collection costs.

Financial Assistance

Financial assistance from the Academy is provided for those in true need who fully support the Academy. Families must first apply for financial assistance through the Catholic Education Foundation. Applications for such must be submitted each year that assistance is requested. Although there are priority deadlines for the initial rounds of CEF assistance, it is never too late to apply. After using this resource and other available options, such as parish or extended family support, if a family still needs assistance, a request may be submitted to Holy Angels Academy for review. The Board of Trustees determines whether to approve assistance. When the Academy provides assistance, a work-study program is made available. It is important for parents to know that Holy Angels Academy does not have a separate tuition assistance fund. However, faith in God's providence always enables us to help those in genuine need.

Refund Policies

- Application, registration, and book/material fees are non-refundable.
- If a student leaves for any reason during the school year, responsible parties must pay tuition fees as follows: 25% of tuition from the 1st day of school through Sept 30. 50% of tuition from Oct 1 - Nov 15. 75% of tuition from Nov 16 - Jan 31. 100% of tuition after Jan 31.

Tuition Philosophy

Holy Angels Academy strives to keep tuition affordable. Generous discounts are provided for families with more than one child attending. Every family is expected to contribute to the education of its children to the best of its ability. Those who have the financial means to do so are encouraged to make contributions to the Academy beyond tuition payments, which will also allow them to claim a tax deduction for charitable giving. As noted in the Parental Agreement, all families are expected to participate in certain fundraisers and tasks to help address the shortfall not provided by tuition. Only with this help, the contributions from generous benefactors from the larger community, and the sacrifices of teachers and staff, will Holy Angels Academy continue alive and well.
